1.May-17.May 2023 6.grad school trip to Denmark



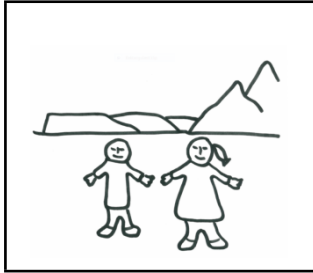
To Oxen Expedition Engagement Network
